Continuing Education Program Audit for 2024

As part of its quality assurance process, 20% of registrants' continuing education submissions will be randomly selected for review. This means the continuing education committee (CEC) will review these continuing education submissions in detail to verify that the goals were clear, the activities aligned with the goals, and there was evidence of intentional learning. Audits have been completed, and the audited dietitians have received feedback.
